

# High Holiday Childminding and Supervision

In order to improve the planning and programming for Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur childminding and youth supervision, all families with children who do not qualify for seats in the sanctuary (i.e. 2 years – 9 yrs of age) have been billed on the general synagogue invoicing as follows for the three days:

- \$25 – for one child
- \$20 - for a second child
- \$15 – for each additional child

The program will run from 10:00 am to 1:00 pm on all three days and will include:

1. childminding for kids 2 – 5 years of age by paid staff
2. supervision and program for 6 – 10 year olds by paid staff
3. increased security and peace of mind
4. less dependence on parental volunteering than in previous years
5. games, crafts, etc
6. healthy snacks and refreshments only for kids registered in the program

A reminder...

There will be Junior Congregation for children 6 – 10 years of age from 10:00 – 1:00 pm

**Registration for this program must be prepaid by Tuesday, September 27<sup>th</sup> – no later.**

We look forward to your co-operation in helping make the High Holy Days meaningful, safe and fun for our kids while the parents relax and participate in the service in the sanctuary.

**(please: note infants and toddlers 0 – 2 are welcome to attend, but must be with parent and register (no fee)**

As well, the staff is not able to attend to a child if a diaper needs changing. If your child/ren are not toilet trained, you will have to check on him/her to change the diaper.

For the children 2 – 5 years old, you are requested to assist in the supervision for at least 2 half hour slots (email to follow to assist in selecting times that meet your needs best).
